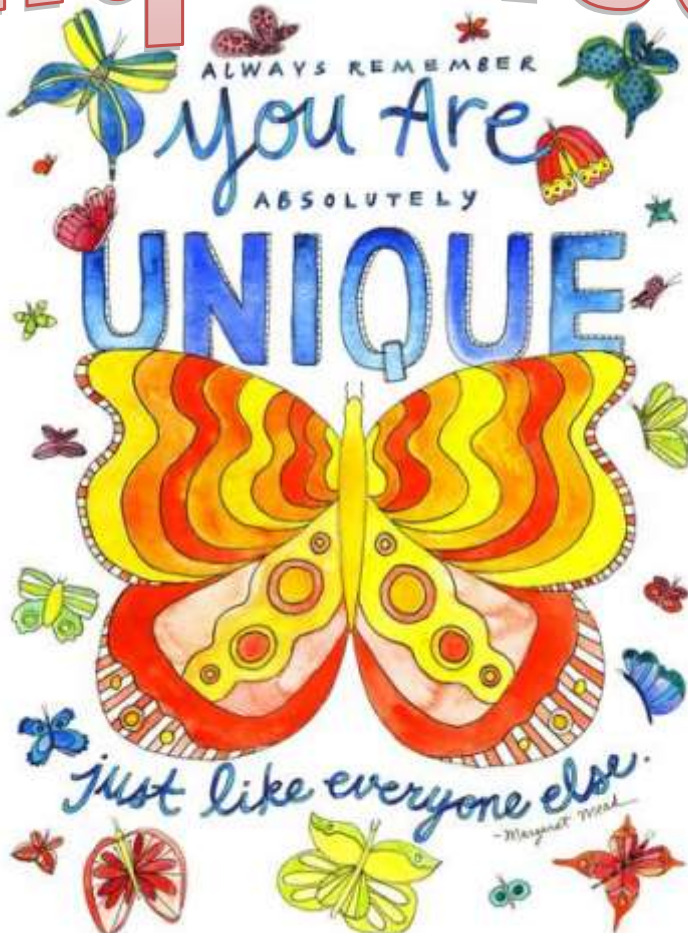
Kia ora whanau,

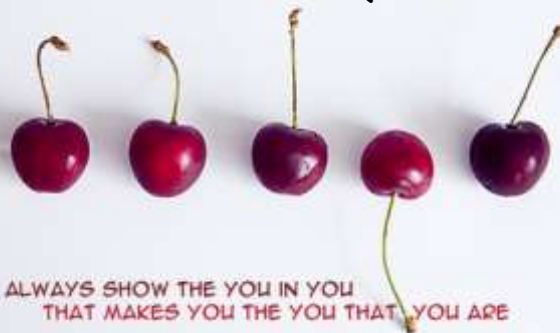

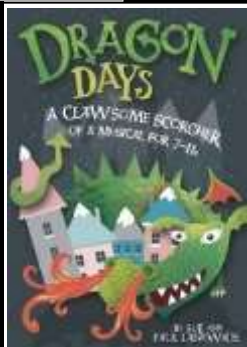
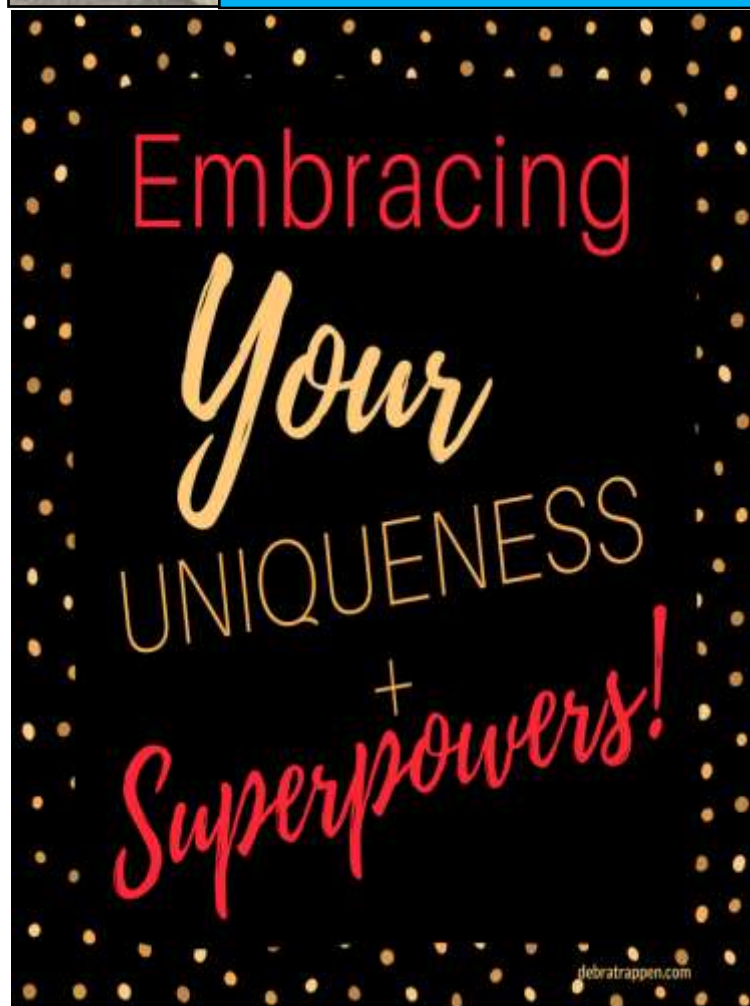
