

## PHONE CALL REGARDING CONNECTIVITY - Ministry of Education

As part of the Equitable Digital Access Project the Ministry of Education has said they will be ensuring every student in our school has equitable internet access. The urgency of this has increased following the Covid-19 Pandemic. 


**The Bay of Plenty Rugby Holiday Programme is back for 2020!**
