PHONE CALL REGARDING CONNECTIVITY - Ministry of Education

As part of the Equitable Digital Access Project the Ministry of Education has said they will be ensuring every student in our school has equitable internet access. The urgency of this has increased following the Covid-19 Pandemic. This is normal as a result of capacity, coverage, and available connectivity solutions for different addresses. We have been advised that some rural areas will require a technician to visit the household for connection. You will be advised if this is the case and each address may have a



separate process. The exciting outcome of this should be that we all enjoy affordable, fast, unlimited internet regardless of our location!




