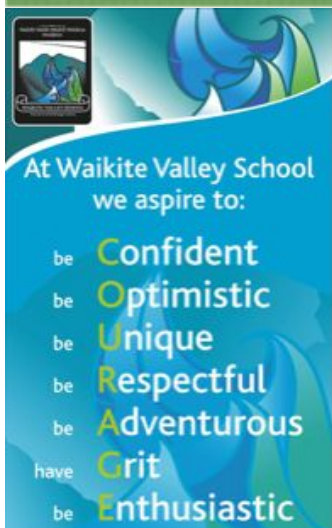

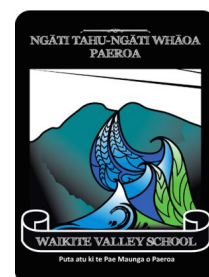

Y1 - Y2 FUN STICKS PROGRAMME - Cost is \$37.00

This year Funsticks will be 1 block of 6 weeks. The block will consist of 5 weeks of learning skills with mini games at the end and the 6th week having a mini tournament. This block will start on **Saturday 8th August**. The club has sticks available if required. Mouth guards & shin pads must be worn. Equipment is not to be shared.

Y5 - Y6 KIWI STICKS

Start date – **Saturday 25th July**

Fees include all affiliation fees, umpire fees and game fees - Maxis \$60.00 per player playing on half turf. Maxi games will be 20 minutes each way with a 2 minute half time. Double headers may be played. Games will generally be played between 8am and 10.45am. Mouth guards and shin pads are compulsory. Equipment is not to be shared. **Draws & Results** All draws and weekly results will be posted on the Rotorua Hockey website.

KWIK STICKS

Fees include all affiliation fees, umpire fees and game fees. Fees have been reduced to reflect a shorter season, but also to reflect the reduction in affiliation fees from Hockey NZ, BOP Hockey and Rotorua Hockey receiving funding to cover some costs. This will be the only year that fee reductions will be offered.

Fees 2020 • Intermediate \$75.00 per player playing on full turf

Intermediate games start Friday 25th June with 12 weeks of competition. Games will generally be played between 4pm and 9pm. Please note that we will be enforcing that only players, goalies and umpires are to be on the field. Coaches/Managers and players waiting to be subbed must remain in the dugout unless subbing.

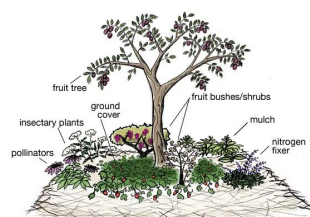
