General Business:

- Fundraising ideas 2020
 - Rochelle Hoole Oxford pies charge us wholesale, we charge on with \$1-\$2 profit per pie. Useful during calving. Range of savoury and sweet products in a few different sizes and pack options. Earliest they can do is Thurs 20 August for delivery. Prize for most sold. Forms to go out first week of Term 3 2 week order period.
 - Chocolate fundraising discussed but put aside for the meantime
 - Wine fundraiser labelled with school for around \$3 mark-up per bottle. Save this for around lead-up to Christmas. Tasting night?
 - Honey Wraps leave this one....
 - Sandwich wraps neek creatz not popular with those present....
 - Halloween event (Full moon this year): children's disco this will happen in Term 3 Thursday 24 Sept 5-7pm
 - Adult scare event/drive in movie Term 4

 - Since the Gala Day/Car boot sale was cancelled, I wondered if we could make use of the Hall and suggest
 having some smaller fairs maybe once a month with a theme such as books and toys or homewares.
 People could still pay for a stall/spot and we could have activities/games for kids (similar to gala day
 activities but indoors) and coffee/tea and cakes/hot food (morning tea/lunch) available for purchase in
 the supper room.
 - Another thought was putting on a high tea for the community or CWI ladies. We could also do something for the males of the community but I'm not sure what ideas?
 - Family activities/local walks book. Look at for Term 4, 2020 Jasmine Trumper
- Milo during Term 3 some time ago in the past, the PTA provided Milo for school students during the winter months. I am not sure if this was a fundraiser or not but thought it could be. That is during Term 3 or just the colder months of July/August, could we supply Milo to students at a cost of say 50c a cup (i.e. \$2.50/week, \$2/week for 4 days or \$1 for a couple of days) during the morning tea break? A couple of parents could come in and prepare the Milo and serve it in named cups supplied by students. Once they have had their drink, return the cup to a classroom bucket or tray and with the assistance of a couple of students from each class (maybe not Pod 1, GPA could help?), they wash the cups after morning tea (or during) and place on a tray in their classroom for the next day/use. Milo in a big tin is about \$25-30 but I'm not sure on milk costs and how much would be needed. The other thing to consider would be those who are dairy free, so a possible soy milk option for those children could be considered. Thoughts? Discussed seemed like a lot of work decided to leave it for now. Look at for a special day or treat.
