







INVOICE

END OF YEAR SCHOOL INVOICES

Attached to this newsletter are the end of year invoices for each student. We rely on your payments to ensure our school can afford the resources

necessary to provide the education our kids need. The school struggles with finances, largely due to our status as a Decile 10z school. The Ministry of Education uses deciles to target funding, for state and state-integrated schools, to help them overcome any barriers to learning that students from lower socio-economic communities might face. The higher the school's decile, the less funding it receives. Therefore, we receive the least amount of government funding given we are the highest decile possible. This means that the money we request in our invoices is absolutely needed for the basic running costs of the school.

Please pay any outstanding amounts before 4th December so we can tidy up our accounts before the end of the year. If we have made an error on the invoice, please phone, message or email us so we can rectify it.

Payments can be made in installments via direct debit (Waikite Valley School - 12-3155-0006515-00), with a cheque, using the EFTPOS at the office or with cash.

Any monies outstanding at 4th December will handed to the School Board of Trustees to follow up.
