

School hours resume at 9am-3pm 9 (Morning 11-11.45am/ Lunch 1.15-2pm)

In 2021 we continue to build on our cornerstones of the C.O.U.R.A.G.E. values and practising Mindfulness daily. In addition, we have two major learning focuses for the year:

- Te Reo Maori improving our school wide fluency and ability to use basic te reo daily
- Exploring links between writing and the arts using our passion and enthusiasm for dance, drama, music and visual art to feed into our writing in order to improve the quality and depth

Mrs Pearson will continue her Maths Specialist Teaching role on Thursdays. This will include working with the other classrooms and teachers to spread the learning and strategies that improved our mathematics school wide in 2020.

Mrs Dinning will be leading the literacy work this year, starting in Term 1 with Reading Together workshops held in the evenings to give skills, strategies and confidence to parents when reading with their children at home. This is targeted towards our kindy, Pod 1, Room 2 and Room 3 parents. More information will be provided soon. Mrs Dinning will also run the Accelerated Literacy programme later in the year to assist some students to achieve higher levels in reading or writing.

Mrs Hunter, Mrs Twiddy and Mrs Dinning will also be learning about and implementing some new reading strategies, based on the Science of Reading. There will still be continued use of successful strategies we have used in the past, but we are exploring some new research based, structured approaches to improving reading acquisition and achievement rates in our school. Mrs Curtis will also continue to run Steps to Literacy sessions with a select group of students (20 minutes structured literacy and short term memory tasks daily).

Matua Grant will continue to work with the classes, teaching us our powhiri skills, waiata, haka, local stories about the history of our area and enhancing our te reo. Matua will be in school on Mondays.

This term we are investigating 'Climate Justice' as a central kaupapa across the school. This will be looked at in our school newsletters too, so that the learning conversations continue into the student's homes and wider community.

The PE uniforms will be issued next week. These are given to each child to use over the year and return at the end of term 4. We have purchased an additional 50 uniforms this year thanks to a grant from Sport Waikato.
