HEALTH REPOROA - SCHOOL NURSES FOR YOUR SCHOOL

To all staff and students and their whanau, just letting you know who we are and how to contact us regarding any health concerns you may have for your tamariki/children. Please feel free to give us a call, send an email or text us if you want us to contact you.

My name is Melissa Brennan I have worked for Health Reporoa for 7 years and before this I was a Paediatric nurse at Rotorua Hospital. This year I have taken on the immunisation coordinator role in the schools. As part of this programme we offer the 11 year old Boostrix vaccine as well as the Gardasil (HPV) Vaccine in year 8.

My name is Jane Maisey and I have been a nurse with Health Reporoa for many years now. We try to visit all schools at least monthly but will go as needed, for instance if there is a head lice outbreak and schools want us to get involved. We can also support any health initiatives such as handwashing/ nose-blowing and all those basics to avoid spreading bugs. We also do puberty talks for the senior students, Year 6 and above.

My name is Kelly and I have joined the Health Reporoa team in the middle of last year with a background in surgical and rural nursing. I am looking forward to starting the school year to meet more of the faces in the community, and doing what I can to help our tamariki lead a healthy life.
