So, I need your help!

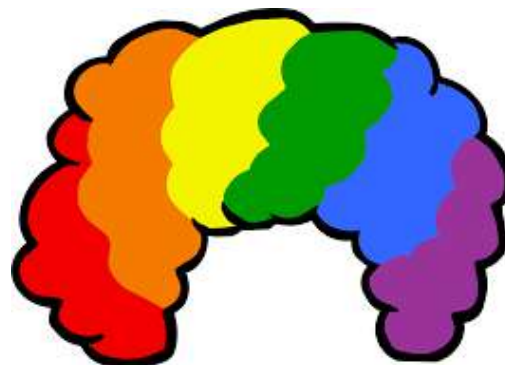
