All students will see the shows at the dress rehearsals this week.

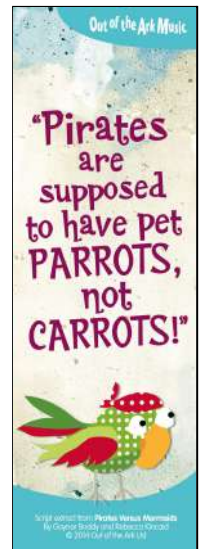
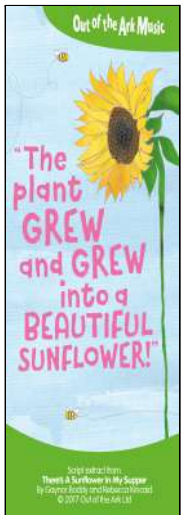

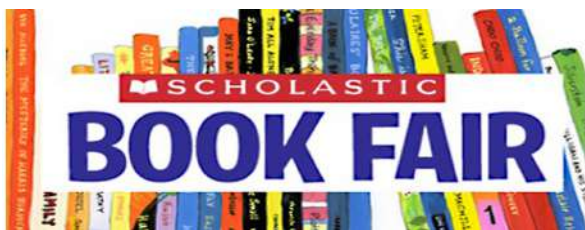
