




WEETBIX Kiwikids Tryathlon

The school will be holding our own Weetbix Tryathlon Challenge on March 1st. In preparation for this we will be swimming daily, running regularly, and the children are encouraged to bring their bikes on their class's Bike Day (same as last year). We will have a course around the field that they will be able to do laps on, as well as riding on the pump track. For a minimal cost of \$5 per child each participant will receive a medal and t-shirt upon completing the challenge. Distances will be set on consultation with class teachers and the aim is for them to be challenging but accessible to all.

Waikite Valley School Camp 2022 - MiCamp Taupo
