WAIKITE VALLEY SCHOOL VALUES

Our school values are: **COURAGE** - Confidence, Optimism, Uniqueness, **Respect**, **Adventurousness**, **Grit** & **Enthusiasm**.

These were developed by our school leaders in 2019 and we have talked about them, modelled them and rewarded students for displaying them in and out of the classroom. Every week we hold a 'School Values Assembly' where we draw out names of the students who have been nominated by a teacher or fellow student for showing one of our values. Each name drawn (usually 5 a week) gets to pick a small prize out of our goodies box. Every name in the draw is awarded house points - Tahu or Whaoa. We do this to ensure the values are alive and it provides motivation for the children to practice these values and develop them as habits. The teachers will also talk about the values in class and the students discuss and brainstorm what each of these values mean and what they would look like in classes, the playground or at home.

Primary School Cricket

Term 1 2022 Out-of-school Programme

SuperSmash Cricket (Ages 5-8 approx) – Thursday afternoons

- Supersmash Cricket is an entry level coached programme, best suited to children 5-8 years old, and designed to help participants learn the basics of cricket
- 6-week programme from 17th Feb November to 24th March 2022 from 3.45pm – 4.45pm at Smallbone Park.
- Cost is \$25 for the 6-week programme, or \$65 if the child wants to purchase a 'cricket pack' which includes a Northern Districts plastic cricket bat, ball, backpack, hat and drink bottle.
- Mixed genders and all gear provided

Incrediball Cricket (Ages 8-11 approx) – Thursday afternoons

- Incrediball is a modified game of cricket using a soft ball / plastic gear. Its suited for children who understand the basics of cricket or have reasonably developed hand-eye coordination.
- Games held Thursday, 3.45pm till 5pm (approx.) at Smallbone Park, Devon Street.
- Starts on 17th Feb November to 31st March 2022 from 3.45pm – 5.00pm (approx.)
- Costs for Incrediball is \$35 per player
- Incrediball teams are required to have a coach and someone to score / umpire
- Mixed genders and all gear is provided.

Hardball Cricket – (Ages 8-11 approx.) - Saturday Mornings

- Wooden bats and protective gear are used as well as a hard cricket ball.
- Hardball teams are 8 aside
- We have 8 teams in our competition which started in Term 4 2021.
- If you have players who wish to start hardball cricket but were not part of a team for Term 4 2021, please let me know and I can try and fit them in if numbers allow. If we can't fit them in, we'd recommend them playing Incrediball.
- Games start at 9am and are played in either Rotorua or occasionally Tokoroa or Whakatane.


