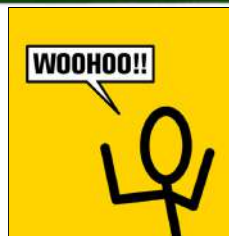


\$100 supermarket Voucher - on

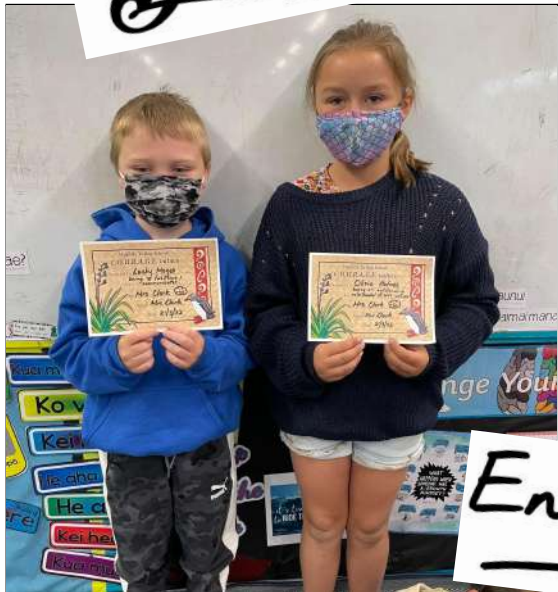

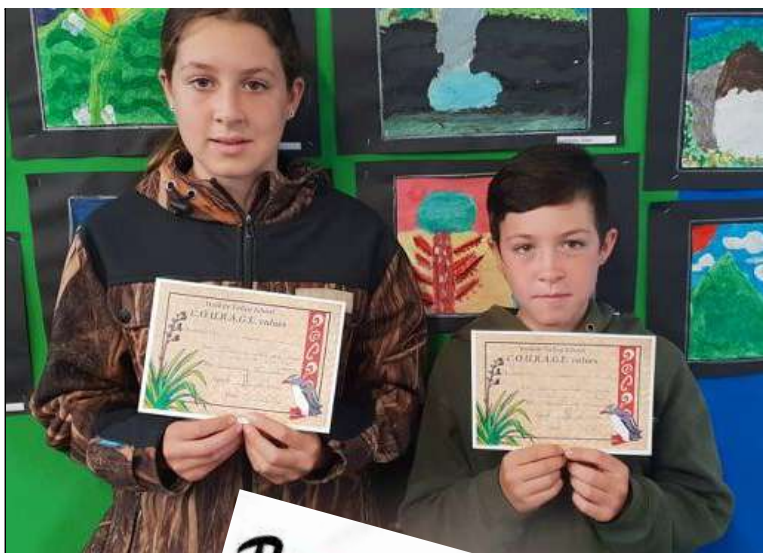

ALL CLOTHES SHOULD BE NAMED

- 2x Bath towels
- Togs
- Sleeping bag
- Pillow with pillowcase
- 3 pair long pants
- 2 pair shorts
- 5 shirts
- 3 warm jerseys
- Raincoat (waterproof)
- Warm jacket or woollen shirt
- Lunch box, Drink Bottle (labeled with your name) and school bag (You must bring a packed lunch the day we leave)
- Pair of shoes or boots (not gumboots) for walking in the bush.
- Pair of sandals/jandals/slip on shoes for wearing around camp
- 5 pair of underwear

- 5 pair of socks
- Toothbrush, hairbrush, soap, shampoo, and other toiletries in toilet bag or plastic bag
- Pair of pyjamas
- Torch
- Reading Book
- A game to play at camp (cards, small travel game etc)
- Sun cream/insect repellent
