

**Where:** Schnuriger Farm (Starting in the paddock directly opposite the Kindy)

When: Wednesday 1st June 2022. 11am start (Will post on Facebook by 10.00am if postponed).

**What to bring:** Warm jacket for before and after running. Would be great if the kids wore their school PE gear, with thermals under if necessary – if you don't have a uniform please see the office. Shoes optional. WARM CHANGE OF CLOTHES FOR AFTER THE RUN.

**Marshalls:** We love to have parents cheering the kids along and helping out on the course. Please let us know if you are willing and able to take on this role.

**Parking:** Supporters can park on the edge of the school field (past the kindy parking), or carefully on the road verge if you deem it safe.

**The Course:** Each race starts and finishes in the paddock opposite the kindy – the younger kids have a flatter run, with the older kids taking on a more challenging hill run.

Distances:	5-6 year olds = 500m	7-8 year olds = 1km
	9-10 year olds = 1.5km	11+ year olds = 2km

We will start with the 5 year olds and work our way through the ages to the longer races. If any adults would like to have a trot around the course, they are more than welcome to join the 11+ year olds.

We will be running in drizzle/light rain if the temperature is good. Please have your children prepared with a positive mindset for this  $\bigcirc$  and a warm change of clothes! They will be asked to change out of their running gear (which should be athletic wear - their school PE uniform is great and if you're worried about the temperature have them put a thermal underneath). If you're coming to watch, bring an umbrella or rain jacket. Cross Country running is a winter sport, which is done in the snow in some places! Think of it as an



opportunity to exercise Grit, Courage, Adventure and Optimism!
