Firstly, thank you to the families, staff and students who gave their feedback to the survey to what you would like in the new principal, this has enabled the board to establish a set of criteria for the job vacancy advert and following interview preparations.

The board has made the decision not to rush this vital appointment to the school and has engaged an independent support advisor from the School Trustees Association to assist us in this journey. Due to the timelines involved the board will be appointing an acting principal for the interim following Teresa's departure until the start of the successful new principal. Due to board elections taking place during the appointment process the new board members will be responsible for the interviewing of successful short-listed applicants and will make the final decision on appointing the new principal.

As per recent school newsletter, board of trustee nominations are currently open for this triannual election. If you

have a couple of hours a month to spare and can offer diverse ideas & values to the board and school community, please submit your nomination. We NEED at least 5 nominations. Trustees on a school board of trustees work together to make sure every child/ tamariki reaches their highest possible standard in educational achievement.

As part of that key responsibility, here are some of the things boards do:

- Work with the principal and consult with staff, students and the community
- Set the educational goals and strategic direction of the school
- Monitor progress and let parents know how the school is progressing against its annual targets and how well students are achieving
- Decide how the school's funding will be spent
- Support the school's principal and support the development of all staff
- Oversee the management of staff, property, finances, curriculum and administration

We need trustees who are focused on supporting teaching and learning and the ongoing improvement of student achievement.

For our board to be the best it can be we need people around the board table with a range of these competencies, skills and personal qualities.

**HELPFUL SKILLS:** Strategic expertise - Financial understanding - Legal understanding Risk management - People management - Knowledge of education environment

**PERSONAL QUALITIES:** Integrity - Curiosity - Courage - Interpersonal skills - Genuine interest in the school and its students - Time and commitment - Willingness to learn It is not expected that each trustee will have all of these skills, but a range of skills around the board table is essential
