GPA Garden Project

This term in GPA we are working on building a garden for the school as well as the community. We are learning about what kind of plants like acidic soils and what plants like alkaline soils. We are going to build two raised garden beds, one with acidic soil and the other with alkaline. The beds will be 2m wide, 6m long and 0.5m deep.
