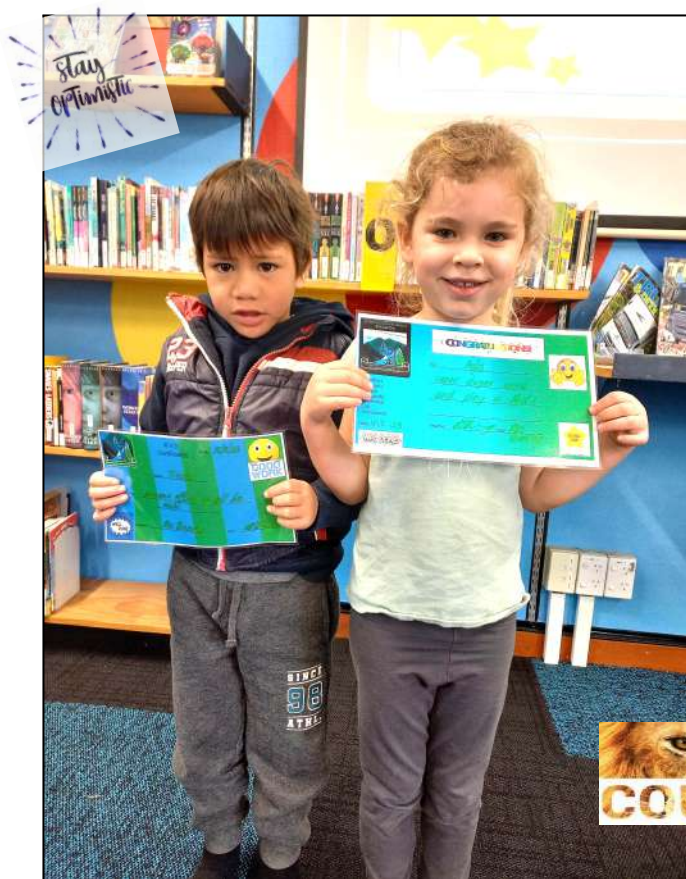
WE NEED YOUR HELP
