**Bring in all your resources tomorrow to make at school (pikelets make at home and finish off just before judging)**

#### **Vaseline Saucer**

Upside down saucer covered with Vaseline, fully covered with petals and leaves, etc. The saucer will be judged on originality. Show imaginative use of petals leaves etc, design, neatness, use of colour, to be a well balanced finished saucer with overall impact.



#### **Miniature Farm**

Create a miniature farm using an interesting container. The container is to have sides and be no larger than 40 cm X 30 cm (eg old roast dish, old milk or drink bottle etc) The farms will be judged on the overall effect, creative use of crafts (ie. as little purchased items as possible). Show colour and texture. Have a well finished balanced farm.

The animals will be judged on imaginative use of dough, design, good technique. The animal to be well balanced and neatly finished.
