#### Community Consultation Feedback

Kia ora koutou,

Our community consultation was really successful and the Board of Trustees would like to offer a big thank you to everyone who took the time to participate. Ngā mihi nui!

The consultation gave us a lot of useful insights and feedback. We had a careful look at your responses and have identified a number of common themes and great ideas that we will take into consideration as we head into 2024.

One thing that was immediately clear is that a lot of families would like the Year 7 and 8 students to have the opportunity to do technology (manual subjects), and in term 4 they started doing food technology at Rotorua Intermediate.

Everyone was unanimous that the school values do reflect their family values, and a lot of people emphasised resilience, which is quite closely related to having Grit, as an important value they would like to see their child/ren develop. The ability to bounce back quickly from setbacks and disappointment is an important life skill. We will continue to ensure that our school is a place where taking risks, making and learning from mistakes, and having a growth mindset is valued.

If you are wanting to support your child's resilience at home, there's an article called "Resilience: how to build it in children 3-8 years " on <u>raisingchildren.net.au</u> that has a lot of good practical tips that suit older children as well.

The children's feedback also offered us useful insights. We asked them what their favourite things about school are, and the most popular answers were reading, writing, and maths. I would like to acknowledge that this reflects the great job our teachers and staff are doing to ensure that learning is fun and engaging. Ka rawe!
