

Strategic Plan 2024-2026




Our Vision for Waikite Valley School is 'Developing Learners for Life'

Community consultation included:



Quality teaching and leadership make the difference for learners and their whānau.


Annual Goals

Success Criteria


- **Achievement Data Shows Progress**
